



Pool Passes & Entrance Procedures

- Season passes are non-transferable. Attempts to transfer a pool pass will result in suspension of the pass.
- Pool passes must be presented, and successfully scanned upon entering the pool. Failure to produce a proper pass will result in the pass holder paying a daily admission. A \$5.00 replacement fee is charged for lost cards.
- A season pass entitles the holder to all regular operating hours at the pool for the duration of the season.
- Non-resident guests must purchase a daily admission and be accompanied by an Avon Lake resident. There is a strict maximum of 2 non-resident guests per resident.
- A responsible person age 14 or over **MUST** accompany children 11 years of age and under.
- An **ADULT** is considered to be 18 years of age and older.
- Children under age 6 must be accompanied at arm's length by a responsible adult at all times while in deep water. Children should never be permitted to swim alone in deep water unless they have passed the swim test. (Deep water is considered to be any water over a child's chin while flat footed.)
- Enter through the front entrance only. All swimmers are strongly encouraged to take a shower before entering the pool.
- No personal items should be left unattended. Management is not responsible for the loss, damage, or theft of personal belongings or valuables while at the pool.
